The City of Hudson invites you to attend a neighborhood meeting on **Wednesday, April 24th, 2019** to discuss the proposed 2019 Vine Street Improvements and Heggen Street Trail Improvements Project. The purpose of the meeting is to briefly outline the scope of the improvements, anticipated schedule, project communications, what to expect during construction, as well as provide an opportunity for residents to ask any questions in a one-on-one setting prior to the start of construction.

The April 24 neighborhood meeting will begin at **6:30 p.m. at Hudson City Hall** inside the Council Chambers. A short formal presentation will take place at the beginning of this neighborhood meeting and staff will be present to answer questions you have regarding the project. 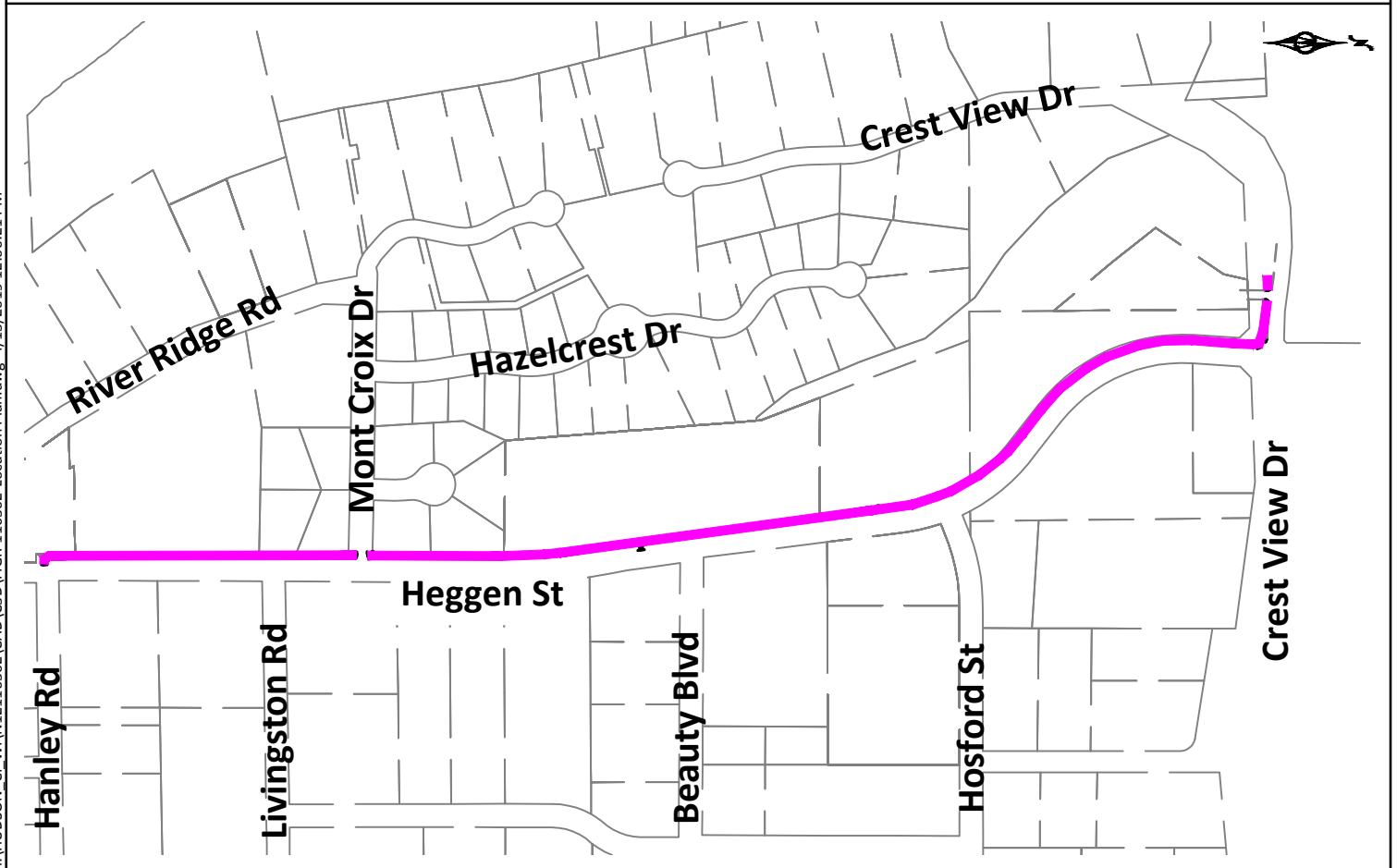
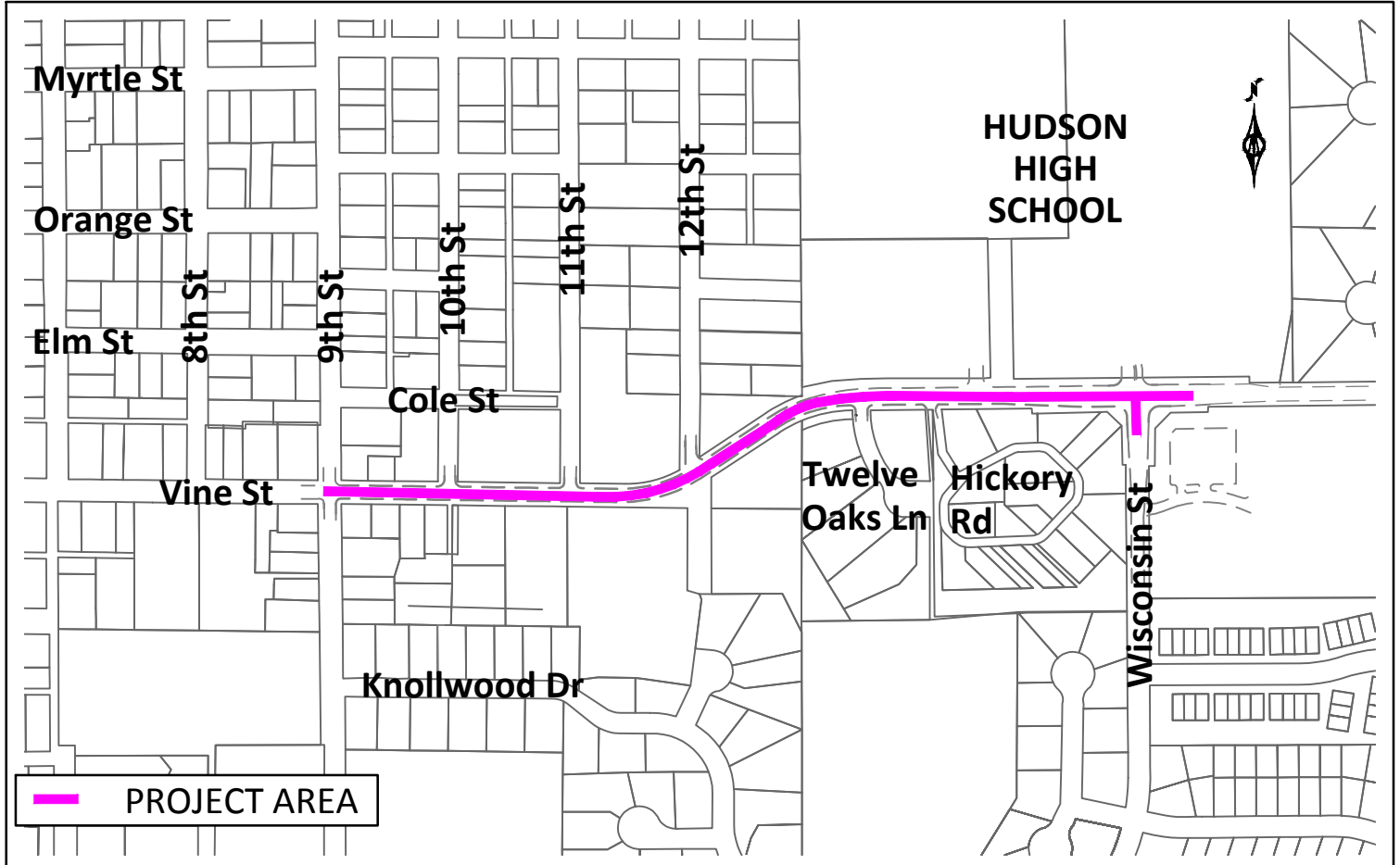
Included with this letter is a map of the project and frequently asked questions related to construction.
