

## 2019 Vine Street Improvements Project Weekly Project Update

**May 31, 2019**

**The City of Hudson is currently reconstructing Vine Street from 9<sup>th</sup> Street to Wisconsin Street. The duration of the project is May 6, 2019 to the substantial completion date of September 30, 2019. Construction includes pavement and curb removals, sanitary replacement, water main replacement, minor storm sewer, curb replacement, pedestrian ramps, asphalt replacement, median reconfiguration and restoration.**

### **Work Completed for the Week of May 27**

A-1 Excavating installed sanitary sewer past 12<sup>th</sup> Street to near Twelve Oaks Lane. The crew also did some storm sewer repairs and cleaned up the subgrade for the weekend.

### **Work Scheduled for the Week of June 3**

A-1 Excavating is planning to continue sanitary sewer installation on Vine Street to tie into the existing sewer near Twelve Oaks Lane. The crew is also planning on installing water main at 11<sup>th</sup> Street midweek and then near 12<sup>th</sup> Street late in the week. There will be some removals as well near 12<sup>th</sup> Street for the work to be completed.

### **Traffic Impacts**

Vine Street will be shut down throughout the duration of construction. All access to homes off Vine Street will always be available from 7:00pm to 7:00am, except during concrete curb and driveway curing time. The currently schedule to reconstruct from 9<sup>th</sup> Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street from May until mid-June and then start on reconstructing from 12<sup>th</sup> Street to Wisconsin Street. Whenever the crews are not working in front of your property, access will still be available to your driveways. Please refer to the notices that will be delivered or call the City Project Manager for any access questions or concerns. There will be a detour set up on Monday for though traffic.
