2019 Vine Street Improvements Project Weekly Project Update

July 12, 2019

The City of Hudson is currently reconstructing Vine Street from 9th Street to Wisconsin Street. The duration of the project is May 6, 2019 to the substantial completion date of September 30, 2019. Construction includes pavement and curb removals, sanitary replacement, water main replacement, minor storm sewer, curb replacement, pedestrian ramps, asphalt replacement, median reconfiguration and restoration.

Work Completed for the Week of June 1 and 8

A-1 Excavating finished their excavation on Vine Street and installed gravel from 9th Street to Wisconsin Street, completing the rest of the removals along the way. The alley across from 10th Street was also graded and graveled. At the end of the week a crew arrived to start concrete sidewalk.

Work Scheduled for the Week of July 15

A-1 Excavating is planning to finish sidewalk patching and begin pouring the curb along Vine Street mid-week. Any driveways off Vine Street will have restricted access after the curb is poured. Notices will be going out to explain the process to those affected.

Heggen Street will also begin on Monday starting with reclaiming the asphalt trail and then grading later in the week.

Traffic Impacts

Vine Street will be shut down throughout the duration of construction. All access to homes off Vine Street will always be available from 7:00pm to 7:00am, except during concrete curb and driveway curing time. The current schedule is to continuing working east up Vine Street and are hoping to be complete by the end of August. Whenever the crews are not working in front of your property, access will still be available to your driveways.
