2019 Vine Street Improvements Project Weekly Project Update

July 19, 2019

The City of Hudson is currently reconstructing Vine Street from 9th Street to Wisconsin Street. The duration of the project is May 6, 2019 to the substantial completion date of September 30, 2019. Construction includes pavement and curb removals, sanitary replacement, water main replacement, minor storm sewer, curb replacement, pedestrian ramps, asphalt replacement, median reconfiguration and restoration.

Work Completed for the Week of June 15

A-1 Excavating finished preparing the gravel for curb and then installed all the curb along Vine Street with the exception of a few intersections to still allow access to residents. Most of the sidewalk and driveways have been poured and will be opened for residents next week.

Heggen Street trail was reclaimed and additional tree trimming was conducted.

Work Scheduled for the Week of July 22

A-1 Excavating is planning to finish concrete sidewalk and driveway replacements early in the week and work on backfilling curb and grading the roadway to prepare for asphalt.

Heggen Street trail will be graded and minor concrete and paving work may occur as well.

Traffic Impacts

Vine Street will be shut down throughout the duration of construction. All access to homes off Vine Street will always be available from 7:00pm to 7:00am, except during concrete curb and driveway curing time. The current schedule is to continuing working east up Vine Street and are hoping to be complete by the end of August. Whenever the crews are not working in front of your property, access will still be available to your driveways.
