CITY HALL CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC

The Hudson City Council has adopted the following policy to keep our staff and visitors safe. If you have any questions about this policy you can contact City Administrator Aaron Reeves, areeves@hudsonwi.gov or your Council representative, <https://www.hudsonwi.gov/114/Common-Council-Members>

- City Hall will be closed to the public for walk-in business starting Tuesday, October 5, 2021. Appointments can be made for in-person service wearing a mask or via ZOOM. To make an appointment you can call 715-386-4765 or you can contact a department directly, <https://www.hudsonwi.gov/8/Departments>
- Masks will be required for all in-person interactions for both employees and members of the public. Employees working alone in their offices are not required to wear masks.
- This policy will be posted on the doors at City Hall and listed on the city website.
- All public meetings will require masks for both members of the committees/councils and the public. A Hudson Police Officer will be stationed at the door during all public meetings to inform guests, hand out free masks, and enforce the mask policy.
- Anyone not complying with the Mask Policy at a public meeting will be escorted from the building by the Hudson Police. A ZOOM option will be set up to accommodate Council or Committee members who prefer to participate without wearing a mask.
- In order to be flexible and current, the City Mask Policy will be reviewed as a standing agenda item at all Common Council meeting for the next nine months where it can be extended, discontinued, reimplemented, or modified according to COVID-19 transmission data in our area from the St. Croix County Public Health Department.
