

Project Location



Project Needs

- The following project needs have been identified:
 - Pavement Deficiencies: The existing pavement is showing signs of deterioration.
 - Pedestrian Accommodations: Dedicated separated pedestrian facilities do not currently exist along the corridor.



Project Information



- We are proposing to improve 0.65 miles of 11th Street as follows:
 - Rehabilitating the asphalt pavement
 - Adding pedestrian accommodations to the corridor
 - Curb & gutter improvements
 - Storm and sanitary sewer adjustments
 - Water utility improvements
 - Signage/stripping upgrades



Roadway/Pedestrian Improvements

• 11th Street

- Proposed 8 ft. two-way shared use path on west side
- Curb ramps will be installed/added to meet ADA standards
- The City has identified multiple trees along the project limits that will be removed because of the Emerald Ash Borer. Some of these trees may be removed by the City in advance of the project.
- On street parking/shoulder being eliminated to make space for path



Traffic Calming


Reducing roadway cross sections “road diets” have the following benefits:

- Improved safety
 - Reduced speeds
 - Reduced vehicle-pedestrian, -bicycle, and -vehicle conflicts
- Operational and maintenance benefits
- Improved community livability


City Utility Improvements

- Watermain Improvements
 - Water line & service replacement from Laurel Ave to Summer St
 - Minor storm and sanitary sewer adjustments based on roadway construction.



Separate Project Information

- Sanitary Sewer Improvements
 - To be completed prior to 11th Street Project in early 2025.
 - Will have minimal impacts to residents.
 - Work to include (3) spot repairs between Wisconsin Street and Colonial Drive.
 - Work includes upgrades to existing sanitary sewer pipes:
 - Slip lining & grout from Wisconsin St. to Laurel Ave.
 - Slip lining only from Laurel Ave. to Colonial Dr.



Proposed Traffic Impacts

- Proposed traffic impacts:

- The roadway will be open to local traffic and closed to through traffic during construction.
- A detour will be posted.
- Temporary driveway closures will be necessary.
- Local, business, and emergency access will be maintained.
- Construction is currently scheduled to occur in 2025 pending the environmental process and DOT review time. Construction is estimated to end in 2025 or within one construction season.



Real Estate

- Additional right of way needs are currently being evaluated.
